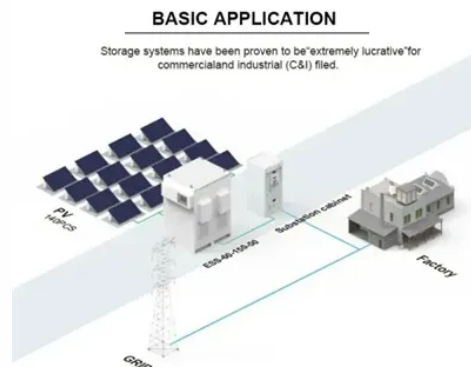


50kw solar power generation in abu dhabi
