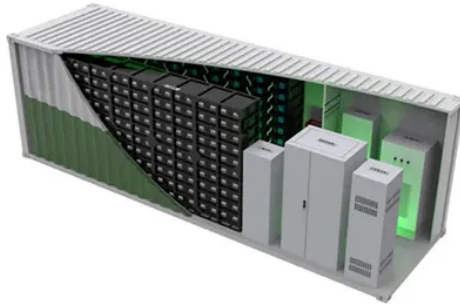


Amsterdam power storage vehicle



Overview

Located in the Westhaven of Amsterdam, the new battery installation—named Giraffe—is the largest in the city, with a power capacity of 10 MW and an energy storage capacity of 47 MWh. With Giraffe, sustainably generated energy can be efficiently stored and deployed during times of. Today the largest European energy storage system using second-life and new electric vehicle batteries in a commercial building was made live. Amsterdam Alderman Udo Kock conducted the official opening ceremony. Developed by GIGA Storage, the project marks an important move to relieve pressure on the Dutch electricity grid and improve the city's capacity to store and distribute renewable.
