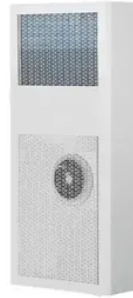


Angola is building a solar power generation system



Overview

Quilemba Solar, a joint venture of TotalEnergies (51%), Sonangol (30%), and Maurel & Prom (19%), is building Angola's largest private solar power plant. The plant, located in Huíla province, will start with 35 MWc capacity and could expand to 80 MWc, powering 40,000. Angola's solar energy program has reached a milestone with the completion of seven photovoltaic plants that collectively underscore the country's pivot toward renewable power and away from diesel-based generation. Officials marked the achievement in early September with the inauguration of the.
