

Are there subsidies for swiss energy storage projects



Overview

Despite the government's objectives defined in the Energy Strategy 2050, there is currently no direct support via subsidy for pumped storage operators in Switzerland. How does electricity storage work in Switzerland?

Electricity storage is not separately defined in the Swiss legislative framework. Switzerland's largest battery storage system has gone into action stabilising the electricity network for transmission grid operator Swissgrid, asset operator Alpiq has said. Switzerland-headquartered developer MW Storage contracted Alpiq to manage and operate the 20MW / 18MWh containerised battery. Switzerland's home solar energy storage market is growing rapidly, driven by federal incentives, regional subsidies, and a strong national commitment to sustainability.
