Overview

Supported by RelyEZ Energy Storage, the Chad solar energy storage project features a 2MW photovoltaic power generation system, a 500kW diesel generator, and a 6. As part of the implementation of the Chad Energy Access Expansion Project (PAAET) – part of the Mission 300 initiative – 145,000 solar kits are being distributed at subsidized rates to households across the country's 23 provinces.
