

Colombia dedicated solar system



Overview

The Colombian government has issued Decree 0972 to encourage solar energy adoption, allowing electricity consumers to install photovoltaic generation systems of up to 5 kW. The program is self-financed, with the installation cost spread across monthly electricity bills over a 120-month period. As electricity fees continue to climb, burdening Colombia will equip more than 1 million low-income households with solar systems to replace subsidies, cut bills and add capacity to the grid. The Colombia solar scheme aims. BOGOTA, Feb. The project will generate approximately 403. Established under Decree 0972 of 2025, the “Colombia Solar” program shifts support for strata 1-3 households from recurring state subsidies to self-supply through solar panel. CONPES 4158 declares the Colombia Solar program of strategic importance, with 8,3 billion pesos for 2026-2030.
