Overview

To discharge a capacitor, unplug the device from its power source and desolder the capacitor from the circuit. Connect each capacitor terminal to each end of a resistor rated at 2k ohms using wires with alligator clips. Wait for 10 seconds for a 1000 μ F capacitor to discharge. It's often safe to discharge a capacitor using a common insulated screwdriver; however, it is usually a good idea to put together a capacitor discharge tool and use that for electronics with larger. Depending on the discharge process you wish to follow, you will need the following to discharge a capacitor: During the capacitor discharge process, you want to take note of the following practices: Ensure your grip on the capacitor is solid to prevent it from slipping away and making contact with.
