

Is there power in the neutral line of the battery cabinet output



Overview

Power passes through the rectifier and inverter to the output when the mains supply is available, powering the necessary or essential loads. The battery is always completely charged in this mode. The battery powers the inverter during power outages, keeping critical. The panel is powered by 120VAC single phase (USA).
