Overview

The first phase of the Ehoala Solar Park, which was finished in late April, includes 14,640 solar panels with an 8MW electricity output. The solar farm will grow by an additional 6MW in the future second phase, and a 19-turbine wind farm will be added, adding an extra 16MW.
