Overview

The project features a 45 MW / 90 MWh BESS facility, representing the country's largest battery, and is part of the broader Transmission Expansion and Energy Storage (TEES) program. Funding support for TEES is being provided through the World Bank, under Loan and Grant numbers. By 2030 the Namibian government plans to increase the share of renewable energies (RE) in its electricity generation from around 30% to 70%. With a growing share of RE the need for measures to maintain and improve energy supply stability is also growing. A battery storage system such as the KfW.
