Poland currently leads the region with the largest installed solar capacity, surpassing 23 GW, while Hungary saw the most dramatic rise, with solar's share of electricity generation jumping from 4% in 2019 to nearly 25% in 2024. Over the past five years, Central Europe has transformed from a coal-reliant region into one of the fastest-growing solar power hubs on the continent. Countries like Hungary, Poland, Czechia, and Slovakia have more than quintupled their solar generation—outpacing the EU average growth rate by.
