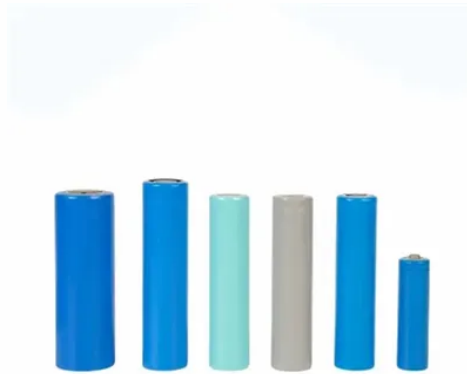


Solar and energy storage projects under construction in niger

These initiatives aim to reduce the country's dependence on electricity imports from Nigeria, marking a pivotal shift toward.
