

Solar energy in moldova

Today about 400MW of renewable energy capacity has been installed in the Republic of Moldova – of which about 230MW of solar PV, and 170MW of wind capacity. To reach net-zero by 2050, the renewable energy installed capacity in Moldova will have to increase from 400MW in 2024 to. The Republic of Moldova is making significant strides in its energy transition, recording steady monthly increases in installed renewable energy capacity (E-SER). At the end of October 2025, total installed capacity reached 932. 81 MW, marking an increase of 35. According to CNED, photovoltaic installations dominate the sector, accounting. Moldova is undergoing a deep and significant energy transformation, with 2025 marking a crucial turning point in its shift from a heavy reliance on Russian gas to a future powered by renewable energy sources. The government's plans to phase out Russian fossil fuels have yielded remarkable results.
