Current tenders typically require 500kW+ capacity systems with 4-hour minimum storage duration. Are there local content requirements?

Bidders must commit to 15% local workforce participation and 10% local material sourcing where feasible. Looking to participate in Somalia's. The Somali government has kicked off a tender for the design, supply, installation, testing and commissioning of a 55 MW solar plant with a 160 MWh battery energy storage system (BESS) in Mogadishu. The deadline for applications is April 14, 2025. This facility, to be grid-connected to the country's largest electricity supplier Beco, is planned to be located.
