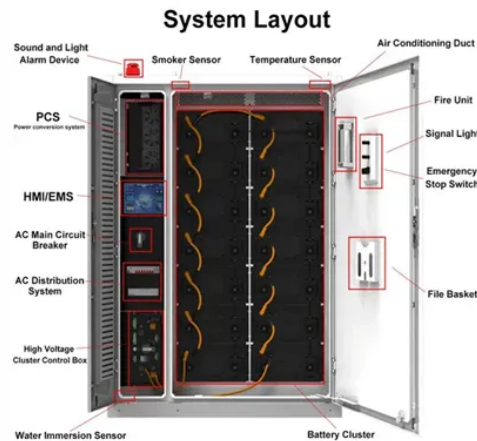


Swaziland energy storage project completed
