It's still the backbone of 95% of global grid storage today! Home energy storage refers to residential energy storage devices that store electrical energy locally for later consumption. Usually, electricity is stored in lithium-ion rechargeable batteries, controlled by intelligent software to handle charging and discharging cycles. Before electricity grids existed, ancient Chinese dynasties. As the world becomes increasingly reliant on renewable energy sources and strives for sustainability, the role of Energy Storage Systems (ESS) has grown exponentially. Around 200 BC, the Greeks used water clocks and counterweight systems in elevators. These structures stored gravitational.
